Please can you remember that lunch time collect is **11:50** and drop off time for afternoon session is **12:00**. This is a very busy time at the preschool so please ensure you collect your child promptly.

We appreciate donations of fruit to share with each other at snack time.

Covid update

Our current policy remains that if you have someone that has tested positive in your household, we ask you to keep your child home for 10 days. We have had an increase in the number of households with positive cases and several preschool children have then tested positive between day 5 & 7 of their isolation. We will update you via email as soon as any decision has been made to change our policy.
